Lighting Facilities Provided For The Festival

The stage is divided into areas **A** to **P** as shown on the stage plan. Each area is lit by two independently controlled colour circuits, one warm and one cold. These colours can be mixed to give an appearance of anything from bright sunshine to cold dingy light. The light in each area partially spills over into the areas around it.

The cyclorama will be lit with light blue and/or dark blue, but red, orange and other colours can be provided if requested.

Follow-spots can be used. **Both are operated from inside the control room.** We provide a lighting board operator, but expect you to operate the follow-spots if you want them.

A few "specials" (extra lights specifically for your play) as well as "practicals" (table lamps, etc) and special effects can be provided. We will try and meet your wishes by a combination of these and the standard lighting areas.
